*Use key terms and images to make it informative and eye catching.*

Create a presentation to give to the class on a topic of your choice.

*Use PowerPoint, presentation software or create your own visual aids to give a short presentation to the class.*

**Design** or **make** a building using **3D shapes**! How about a **temple**?

*Look at your house and other buildings around - what 3D shapes can you spot? Cubes, cuboids, prisms, cylinders? Any others? How could you use these 3D shapes to make your own building?*

Create an information **poster** about the topic you are learning about in Science.

*Use any key terms you have learnt, make it informative and eye catching!*

Draw a new front cover and blurb for a book of your choice.

*Choose a favourite book. Design and draw a new front cover for that book and make sure it is eye catching! Then write a blurb, 2 paragraphs long that makes someone want to read the book.*

With the help of an adult, make your own Indian Food. Take a photo and stick it in your book.

Write the recipe including equipment, ingredients and instructions.

Identify **key terms** we have learnt in this project and write a dictionary

*Find out the definitions of the key words and write a glossary to help you learn spellings and keywords.*

**Money Hunt** - find examples around your home of how money is used. Look at the **cost of items in a shop** and write them down.

*How much cash does one of your grown-ups have? How much do they spend on weekly shopping?*

Use a range of images, colours and materials to create an Indian collage/mood board. Remember to use lots of interesting textures, shapes, colours and patterns.

Practise your **times tables**. Times tables are really important! *Write the multiplication and division facts for a different table each week.*

*Learn your 3, 4 and 8 times table facts!*

*If  $6 \times 4 = 24$ , what is  $60 \times 4$ ? What about  $90 \times 8$ ?*

Write down different **number bonds**. Maybe two numbers which make 10, 50 or even 17?

*Try the inverse subtractions as well!  
 $7+3=10$  so  $10-7=3$*

Practise the spellings you have been given this week. Write them in grown-up, descriptive or funny sentences!

*Can you include dialogue, a simile or an expanded noun phrase? Don't forget to punctuate correctly!*
