Reading

- Read as often as possible at home looking for digraphs that they haven't learnt
- Children do paired reading daily after lunch and are heard by the Teacher once a week and a TA once a week during this reading session.
- Not in stages anymore - sorted by phonic phases.
- Children change own books from given box or shelf.
- Oxford Reading Buddy - online comprehension (more details to follow)

Reading Strategies



- Use your sounds.
- Break up the word into smaller words.
- Use the picture clues.
- Read on.
- Check to see if it makes sense.
- Do you know any words that look similar?
- Segment the word into chunks.

Spelling

In year 1 children should revise

- All letters of the alphabet and the sounds which they most commonly represent
- Consonant digraphs which have been taught and the sounds which they represent
- Vowel digraphs which have been taught and the sounds which they represent
- The process of segmenting spoken words into sounds before choosing graphemes to represent the sounds
- Words with adjacent consonants
- Guidance and rules which have been taught

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
Phonics Screening Check

The Phonics Screening Check assesses children's phonics knowledge. It helps confirm whether children have made the expected progress. In 2020 the check will take place during the week beginning Monday 8th June.

How does the check work?

Children sit with Mrs McIvor and read a mixture of 40 real and made up words.

Normally takes 10 - 15 minutes but there is no time limit. If children struggle we can stop.



Home Learning
