English Curriculum Highlights

- Continued practice of capital letters and full stops.
- Understanding of other forms of grammar and punctuation (commas, conjunctions, adverbs etc)
- Continued practice of cursive handwriting
- Recapping a range of alternate spellings to familiar sounds.
- In reading there is a high focus on comprehension as well as fluency.

Maths Curriculum Highlights

- Recapping of year 1 knowledge in all areas to then build on.
- Look at numbers to 100 and beyond.
- Place value and partitioning of numbers into 10's and 1's
- Addition and subtraction introducing column method.
- Multiplication and Division, learning 2, 3, 5 and 10 times table.
- Linking above to fractions and focusing on $\frac{1}{2}$'s, $\frac{1}{3}$'s and $\frac{1}{4}$'s
- Weight, capacity, shape, space and measure.

How can you help at home

- Early nights, hearty breakfast, be on time

Read, read, read. Let them read a book of their choice to you.

- Writing for different purposes – encourage children to check their own spellings
- Applying maths to real life situations. Playing maths games at home including board games!
- Continue to practise reading and spelling common exception words
- Pick your moments to do their home learning. If they are tired then leave it until a better time.
