<p>Make a model woolly mammoth out of anything you wish. Imagination is the key!</p>	<p>Make a poster that explains the difference between solids, liquids, and gases. Make sure it is well presented.</p>	<p>Create a Stone Age quiz to test your friends and family. Who can get the best score?</p>
<p>Try and make up your own times table song. Maybe you could record it or share it with the class.</p>	<p>Create an information poster about prehistoric musical instruments and musical stones. Use any key terms you have learnt, make it informative and eye catching!</p>	<p>Can you write an acrostic poem about a topic we are learning about in school?</p>
<p>Use natural materials to create a picture of the Stone Age.</p>	<p>Try making rice crispy cakes at home. While you are making them, think about how you change the state of the chocolate to create your cakes. Can you explain what is happening?</p>	<p>Draw a picture, or make a shoebox model, of what your cave would look like if you lived in the Stone Age. Don't forget to label it.</p>
<p>Create a Stone Age Stewed Fruit Stew (which can be turned into a delicious crumble or pie) or Stone Age Oat Cakes. Make sure to write down your recipe and include photos.</p>	<p>Make a creative book review about a book you have read. The more creative, the better, such as the ones below:</p> 	<p>Use a range of images, colours, and materials to create a Stone Age mood board or collage. Remember to use lots of interesting textures, shapes, colours, and patterns.</p>
<p>Stone Age people build shelters to live in using materials they had gathered. Gather some natural materials and build a model shelter.</p>	<p>Create a water cycle experiment. Fill a large bowl with water. Put an empty pot in the middle of the water. Cover the bowl with film and place on a sunny windowsill for a few days. You should soon see the water start to evaporate, it will cool and condense on the film before falling into the empty pot as 'rain'.</p>	<p>Create a leaflet for 'How to survive the Stone Age.' Imagine you are transported back to the Stone Age and need a guide to help you survive. What would the guide say? What tips would it have? Use ICT if you wish.</p>
