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<p>Visit a park or garden. Find 10 examples of different lifecycles (seeds, egg shells) Draw and label anything you find. This could include living things</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Find 2 stories, one with a good King/Queen and one with an evil King/queen. Read them and write about their similarities and differences.</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Choose a flower or tree from a park or garden. Keep a weekly diary showing how it changes as we move from winter to spring. At least 6 entries. Photos, drawings or written descriptions.</p> <p>★ ★ ★</p>	<p>Collect some data. Record in a table, then present it in a graph. (e.g. colour cars on road, types of sweets in bag, number of letters in a name, favourite meals etc)</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Choose 10 containers from your kitchen. Predict which has the biggest and smallest capacity. Then use a measuring jug to check. Were you correct?</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Research and compare the Roman and British Empires. How were they successful? Why did they fall? Use blank world maps and colour in each empire (at its peak). What do you notice?</p> <p>★ ★ ★</p>
<p>Plant 2 seeds (from the same plant) in different places. Observe and compare how they grow, keeping an illustrated diary of your observations.</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Research the lifecycle of a mammal. Present as an explanation text with illustrations (could be repeated for a bird, amphibian or insect)</p> <p>★ ★ ★</p>	<p>Read a news article (newspaper or online). Make a list of 5 facts and 5 opinions from the article. Was it easy to tell fact from opinion?</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Find and list 10 examples of decimals, percentages and fractions at home. (food packaging, user manuals or recipe books etc)</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Prepare a meal for your family. It should be at least 2 courses. Write a menu. (Make sure an adult is around to help keep you safe!)</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Draw a floor plan for your house. Label with the perimeter and area of each room. (At least 5 rooms, to the nearest metre)</p> <p>★ ★ ★</p>
<p>Watch an episode of Frozen Planet II (On IPlayer, rated PG) Write a list of 10 interesting facts.</p> <p>★ ★ ★</p>	<p>If you were king or queen for a day what would you do? Write and draw about your day</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>Find out about Clare Castle, particularly any links to royalty. List 10 interesting facts about it.</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Make a poster titled: How are seeds dispersed? Include facts and diagrams of different methods.</p> <p>★ ★</p>	<p>If you could choose to be king or queen of any country in the world which country would you choose? Why?</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Using squared paper create a symmetrical pattern. The mirror line could be vertical, horizontal or even diagonal.</p> <p>★</p>
