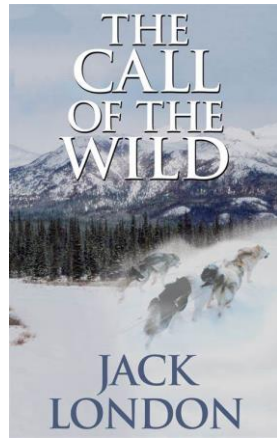
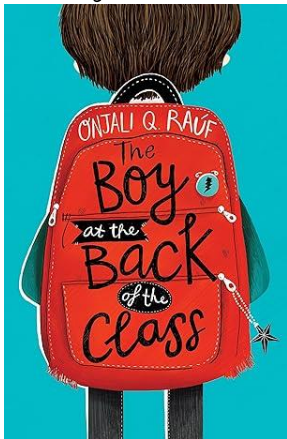

Literacy

This term, our class texts are *The Boy at the Back of the class* by Onjali Q. Rauf and *Call of the Wild* by Jack London. For the first half term, the writing outcomes include: A piece of persuasive writing, free writing, a letter to the Prime Minister, the next part of the story, a news broadcast, a speech and a news feature. For the second half term, the writing outcomes include: reasoning and evidence, a fight scene, non-fiction writing and a presentation on dog sled teams, dialect, a narrative poem a monologue and a story.



Mathematics

This term we will continue to develop our maths fluency skills through maths meetings and in lessons will learn about: shape (including angles and length), converting units, volume as well as lots of preparation and consolidation ready for Year 6!

Homework

You must each week:

- Read at least 3x a week (this can be with or without an adult)
- TT Rockstars at least 3x a week
- 1x Bedrock lesson
- Practise spellings. This can be writing out in your book, making posters, in sentences or spelling tests. This is your choice! See the overview for this week's spellings.

Week A - English focus

Week B- Maths focus

Topic
