Science

In science this term, we will be learning about **'Plants – Seeds and Bulbs'**. Within this topic we will be learning about what seeds and bulbs need to survive and recognising the differences and similarities of seeds and bulbs. Following this we will be investigating **'Growing Up'**. In this topic we will focus on the life cycles of different animals and patterns in these life cycles.

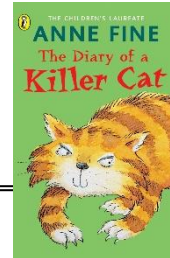
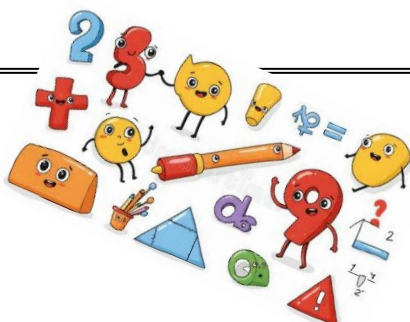

Mathematics

This term we will continue to develop our maths fluency skills through maths meetings and in lessons. We will be looking at statistics and how we can different represent data. We will also continue to learn about time, investigating minutes, hours and how we can apply telling the time to our daily lives. We will build on our knowledge of place value, money and continue to build on core math skills.



English

To start this term, we will be **reading 'Diary of A Killer Cat'**. The sequence of learning will develop children's understanding of the story, characters, themes and language. The unit teaches reading, including fluency, vocabulary and comprehension, and meaningful writing, for a range of form, purpose and audience. We will then be reading **'Tidy'** and **'Greta and The Giants'**. The unit explores the story structure, main character and setting in detail. Children apply what they have learned throughout the unit to create a final piece of writing about how we can look after our environment.



Topic

Our Geography topic this half term is **'Our Wonderful World.'** This unit has a focus on an appreciation of the world by introducing natural and man-made wonders. Next half term we will be flicking back to a History topic. This will be **'Our Local Heroes'**. We will investigate the lives of some of the most significant people in history and our local area.
