We have 3 positive cases of Covid-19, isolated to year 6. Parents in year 6 have been contacted separately.

We would like to remind parents of the need to be vigilant with any cough and cold symptoms and to err on the side of caution at this time.

We are asking parents to remain on the bottom playground at drop off please. Parents and carers should not be coming up to the top playground. If you need to speak to a teacher please could you find a member of duty staff and they will give the message to the class teacher.

All pupils need to join their class line on the top playground and members of staff are on hand to help take pupils up if needed.

We are also asking parents not to congregate near the wall as this blocks late pupils from joining their lines safely and also creates congestion in this area.

Please keep an eye out for any emails as we may need to change measures if needed.

The flu vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of flu. With COVID-19 still in circulation it is important to reduce the number of those becoming ill with flu this winter to help protect them, the NHS and social care. Research also shows that if you get both flu and COVID-19 at the same time you may be more seriously ill.

The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, the type of flu can vary each winter so it is recommended to have it again this year or they won't be protected.

#### **COVID 19 Guidance**

# If your child has cold symptoms or a temperature please ensure they have a Lateral Flow test before attending school.

We are following County and Government guidelines and are monitoring the school's numbers daily. As we are constantly monitoring this situation, we may need to make amendments that meet our own needs and go beyond this government and county guidance. Therefore, we urge you to read all messages from school daily and continue to inform us of any cases within your household. Our priority remains providing a safe and consistent education for our pupils. We also need to ensure that staffing levels are not affected adversely, therefore this will also need to be considered when making any further decisions.

If your child has COVID-19 symptoms they should stay at home and self-isolate immediately. You should arrange to have a PCR test as soon as possible. If this PCR test result is positive, they must continue to self-isolate. If they do not have COVID-19 symptoms, but they have a positive PCR and or LFD test result, they must stay at home and self-isolate and follow the official guidance. Please send a photo of the lateral flow test with the date of test and the child's name to the school office by email to admin@clareprimary.org.

From Monday 17th January, people who are self-isolating with Covid-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting on day 6.

If anyone in the school develops covid-19 symptoms, however mild, they will be sent home and they should follow public health advice. Please keep your child at home if they have symptoms. If you are unsure, please contact the school office for further advice.

#### **Symptoms**

The symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- · recent onset of new continuous cough or
- high temperature or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

We are aware that some children present with other symptoms such as diarrhoea, vomiting, cold, headache, cough and would encourage anyone who is feeling unwell to get a PCR test.
