




# DELLAR SPORTS COACHING

## KEEPING YOUR CHILD SAFE DURING OUR CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY CAMPS

- 01 Parents/guardians to wear masks when dropping off their child/children at the register point and must be socially distanced to others.
