General COVID information

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19 they should remain at home. Arrange for a COVID test via <u>https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test</u> or by calling NHS 119 and inform the head teacher.

If their test is negative and they can return to school when they are well.

If their test is positive, they will need to self-isolate for **10 days** from the date after their symptoms started. All your household members must self-isolate for 10 days, unless they are exempt.

The date of symptom onset is day zero.

Symptoms

The symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- recent onset of new continuous cough or
- high temperature or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

We are aware that some children present with other symptoms such as diarrhoea, vomiting, cold, headache, cough and would encourage anyone who is feeling unwell to get a PCR test.
