Dear Parent/Carer,

Clare Community Primary School - Home Reading Initiative Launch

This half term, we shall be launching our new 'Home Reading Initiative,' which we hope will further support your child in their reading.

Each year group will have a recommended reading list of twenty-five titles, which have been chosen specifically to support children's reading for that age group and can be found on our school website: Curriculum - Home Reading Initiative). With a range of literature, including picture books, poetry, fiction and non-fiction, the aim is to introduce pupils to authors and books that they may not have previously chosen and, consequently, enrich and develop their reading.

Children will still have an Accelerated Reader ZPD book level and will need to be quizzing regularly in school. However, children can now also be working towards completing their recommended reading list. The vast majority of titles on these lists are supported by Accelerated Reader, and children will therefore be able to quiz on these books, although some newer titles, picture books and poetry, may not. Please note that some books, especially newer titles, may not be available in the school library. Children may need to visit their local bookseller or library, which are both fantastic local facilities. However, if your child is struggling to locate a particular title, please let your class teacher know. As children work their way through the titles, they should evidence that they have read them, either by a parent signature in younger years, or by taking an Accelerated Reader quiz in older years, where possible.

Children aim to complete their reading list for their year group and in turn they receive a certificate in Celebration Assembly for every five they tick off on a bingo-style sheet. In KS2, children go on to become a 'Literacy Ambassador' and receive a pin badge if they complete all twenty-five titles or become a 'Word Millionaire' that year. Children who become a 'Word Millionaire' also receive a book of their choice.

I hope that, as a school, we can work together with parents to promote a love of reading

and get children 'hooked on books', meaning that they will be lifelong learners.
