



# DELLAR SPORTS COACHING

## KEEPING YOUR CHILD SAFE DURING OUR CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY CAMPS

- 01** Parents/guardians to wear masks when dropping off their child/children at the register point and must be socially distanced to others.
- 02** Each child will wash hands on entry to the school.
- 03** All activities and safety measures will be adhered to in accordance with the DoFE (Department of Education) guidance.
- 04** Bubbles will be created where children will remain with their groups and coaches all day.
- 05** There will be a minimum of one DSL and paediatric first aid trained member of staff on site each day.
- 06** We will be outside as much as possible. In the event of adverse weather, the hall and other necessary indoor space will be used.
- 07** All equipment and areas will be cleaned after use.
