


Welcome Back!

On that note, I would like to invite you all to attend an Information Afternoon next Thursday, 14th September, between 4 and 5pm.


This will begin with twenty minutes in the school hall where I will run through some of our new initiatives, procedures and expectations. Then parents will go to classrooms



School Clubs I am delighted to be able to present



to you a very comprehensive programme of both after-school and lunchtime clubs that will be running throughout the Autumn term. Several parents had commented on the questionnaire that went out at the end of last term that they would appreciate a wider range of after-school clubs to be available, so I hope you will agree that this represents a real improvement in provision.

Please fill in the form below to book places for each club; the year groups and numbers are stated next to each club. We will be working on a first-come, first-served basis initially, but we will also allocate places in additional clubs fairly so that we can serve as many children as possible. You only need to book clubs that have limited numbers or those which require a payment. Those which have been asterisked require additional payments (details with this form).

I am very appreciative that staff are giving their own time in order to offer these activities and I would like to remind parents that we will expect our customary high standards of behaviour, as outlined in the Behaviour for Learning Policy (please refer to the copy on our website or in the foyer). If a child is not behaving appropriately, they will receive one formal warning which will be conveyed to the parents via a phone-call. If behaviour continues to be unsatisfactory then the child will be asked to leave the club permanently. This will apply to the clubs run by outside agencies also. Likewise, we expect a letter or phone-call if a child needs to miss the club for some reason. If the club is missed for two weeks in a row, without adequate explanation, then the place will be given to someone else.

These forms need to be returned by Monday, 11th September.
Slips indicating which clubs children have been given places on will be sent out by the end of that week and clubs will commence the week beginning 17th September.
